1. Create a Production Group

Start by creating a group to keep your productions organized.

- 1 Click **Add Group**.
- 2 Give your group a name.
Examples: Year 6, Drama, GCSE Drama, Musical Theatre.
- 3 Click **Save Group**.

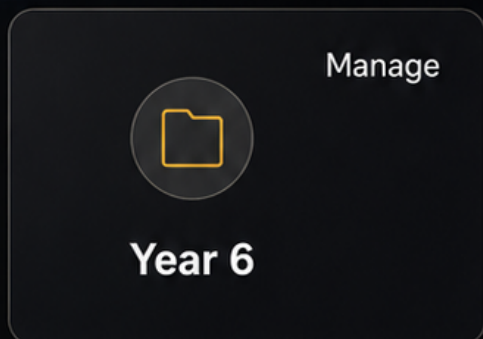

3. Open Your Production

Your new production will now appear in your Production Library.

4. Add Your Music

Add all the music and audio files you need for your production.

- 1 Click **Choose Files**.
- 2 Browse to your music folder.
- 3 Select your files and click **Open**.
- 4 Production Player PRO will automatically create a cue for each file.

5. Add Cue Notes

Add notes to each cue to help guide your performance.

- 1 Select a cue in the list.
- 2 Type your notes in the **Cue Notes** panel.
- 3 Your notes will be visible during playback.

6. Show Menu

The Show Menu gives you access to powerful production tools.

Production Remote



Enter Performance Mode



Enter Full Screen



Manage Production

Production Remote

Display a QR code to control your production from your iPhone or iPad.



Enter Performance Mode

Hides editing controls for a clean, distraction-free performance view.



Enter Full Screen

Maximise the player and remove desktop distractions.



Manage Production

Edit production details and create another production in the same group.



TIP: Use Performance Mode and Full Screen for rehearsals and live shows.



7. Production Remote

Control your production remotely from your phone or iPad.

Scan with an iPhone or iPad to control the current production.

Click Start Remote, then scan the QR code with an iPhone or iPad camera.

Scan the QR code using your iPhone or iPad to connect.



Once connected, you can start, pause and advance cues from anywhere in the theatre.



TIP: Make sure your device is on the same Wi-Fi network.
